



2017 4-H Summer Camp June 5th -9th
Transportation Instructions

****Very important – the bus that will be transporting the youth and luggage to camp has a limited amount of room – please have campers pack as sparingly as possible!****

Lice Check: Per the State 4-H Camping Office, a visual lice check must be done by designated persons on each child immediately prior to getting on the bus for camp. If there are any lice issues, see the "*Additional Information*" attachment for instructions. **Parents/guardians should schedule their time accordingly during the morning for camper drop-off to account for staying with the child until it is established that they can board the bus and the luggage is at the loading area.**

Monday, June 5th: Children arrive between 9:00 – 9:30 am at South County Park – 800 20th Avenue SW, Vero Beach, FL 32962, located on the east side of 20th Ave. SW, just north of Oslo Road (9th St. SW). Please enter South County Park off of 20th Avenue SW, park in a parking spot and walk your child and luggage over to the pavilions located in front of the bathrooms. There will be designated persons for checking in campers, accepting bagged medicines and doing a visual check for lice (see "*Additional Information*"). **Parents/guardians need to stay with their children until the luggage is taken to the loading area and their children can board the bus.** Please schedule your time accordingly. **If your child misses the bus, it will be the responsibility of the parent or legal guardian to make travel arrangements to Camp Cloverleaf at own expense and time.**

Bus Departs for Camp 10:00 am: The bus will drive straight through to Camp Cloverleaf in Lake Placid and the rural route we take does not give us any choices for stopping. **There will be no stops for food, drinks or bathroom during bus travel time.** Please make sure your child has eaten Breakfast and has had something to drink prior to being dropped off. South County Park has bathrooms for the youth to use prior to getting on the school bus.

Friday, June 9th: Bus will be at Camp Cloverleaf around 9:30 am to load for return trip with a scheduled departure time of 10:00am.

Return Pick Up: Bus *should* arrive between 12:00 – 12:30 PM at South County Park, again, in front of the bathrooms. Please schedule your time to account for lateness due to traffic or weather conditions. **I will let you all know via Facebook of our location (where cell signal is available) while traveling back for a more accurate pick up time.**

Bus Ride to and from Camp: Please remember there will be no stops for drinks, food or bathrooms on the way over and from camp.

Not Using the Bus?: If there are any campers who will be arriving or departing from camp that are not using the provided transportation **please let me know as soon as possible in writing** (via e-mail OK), describing who will be providing transport and whether keeping to the scheduled arrival/departure times.

As always, Camp Cloverleaf is a staple to the Indian River County 4-H Program. Camp is a great time for youth to learn self-confidence, make new friends and memories!
