Barn Queen & King

Indian River County has had a “Barn Queen and King” Contest for over six years. This is a great way to meet new friends under the barn and to have fun while at the fair.

Eligibility

All participants must be currently enrolled in 4-H, be in good standing, is participating under the barn in the current IRC 4-H Fair Show and turns in all paper work on time.

Production

The production will take place under the barn, in the arena on opening fair night, Friday, at 7:30 p.m. All participants shall be ready to go at 7:00 p.m. The participants will enter the arena in a single file line, and will line up according to their age division against the stage. Judges will be sitting in the middle of the arena and the announcers will be standing next to the participants to introduce them and to ask them questions. Each Participant will receive their chance to shine by modeling in front of the judges.

Attire

For the production, all contestants must wear “country wear” in order to participate. We recommend that each participant wears nice jeans and closed in shoes for the production. We will not allow participants to wear hats during the production and **all attire must be “4-H appropriate”**. This means no shorts more than 4” above the knee, blouse straps must be at least 2” wide, no spaghetti strap, halter or tube tops, no cut-off or muscle shirts and no offensive or inappropriate language, graphics or logo t-shirts.

Prizes Awarded

There will be **eight awards with four different categories:** Senior Barn Queen/King, Junior & Intermediate Barn Princess/Prince and Cloverbud Barn Princess/Prince. There will be two winners for each category, one male and one female. Senior Barn Queen will receive a tiara and sash; princesses will receive sashes and tiara. Males will receive caps and sashes.

Cost

To enter the production, contestants must pay \$20.00 and turn in all paper work **before the production starts**. The paper work will be read during the production. All paperwork and \$20.00 payment needs to be turned into Beth Stabe (stabem1@bellsouth.net) by 5:30 PM on Friday, opening Fair night.
