Bargar</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Discusses Chapter 482 requirements, such as which pesticides can be used, what equipment can be used, where pesticides can be applied, license application requirements, and how to renew licenses. - Federal and state laws governing pesticides applicator licensing are addressed in addition to record keeping requirements. Harmful effects of pesticides are also discussed including exposure, acute effects, chronic effects, signs and symptoms of pesticide poisoning, and heat stress.
9:30 am – 10:30 am	<p>Environmental Protection – J. Bargar</p> <p>Discusses ways that pesticides can become environmental contaminants and their harmful effects on nontarget plants and animals. The proper ways to transport, store, dispose, and spill cleanup are also discussed.</p>

10:45 am – 11:35 pm	<p>Integrated Pest Management of Ornamentals– C. Kelly-Begazo</p> <p>Discusses the concepts of IPM in the landscape. Teaches how to incorporate these concepts into the maintenance of ornamentals in the landscape.</p>
